- Windows 8
- Windows 7
- Windows XP Professional
- Windows Vista

Client Software Requirements

Colligo Contributor has the following client software requirements:

- Microsoft .NET framework 3.5 Runtime
- Microsoft .NET framework 4.0. Runtime
- Integration with Microsoft Office requires Office 2003 or later
- Microsoft Office 2003 SP2, 2007, 2010, 2013
- Microsoft Office Primary Interop Assemblies (PIAs). Different versions of Office have different PIAs. PIA's must be deployed corresponding with the version of Office installed
- Microsoft Visual Studio 2005 Tools for Office Second Edition (VSTO 2005 SE) Runtime
- Microsoft Visual C++ 2010 SP1 Redistributable Package

Server Software Requirements

Colligo Contributor requires at least one of the following:

- Microsoft SharePoint Server 2010, MOSS 2007, or SharePoint Portal Server (SPS) 2003
- SharePoint Foundation Microsoft Windows SharePoint Services (WSS) 3.0, or 2.0
- SharePoint 2010 Online (Office365)
- SharePoint 2013

Issue #	Description
44338161	In Contributor Client, users can now move (and copy) a file from one location in a SharePoint site to another location in the same SharePoint site by dragging and dropping. 35809563	Sync modes (offline/online) are now properly set up when users connect a new list or library using the Connect to Outlook feature in Internet Explorer. The feature no longer potentially damages the configurations of other previously configured locations in the same SharePoint list or library.
37447593	Windows Authentication now works as expected when configured as part of Claims Based Authentication.
39209491	A deletion of a list item in SharePoint is now properly reflected (deleted) locally after synchronization.
39293411	A rare synchronization scenario that could cause duplicate files or folders to be displayed in Contributor Client has been resolved. After installing this update, it is recommended that the local database be recreated after successfully synchronizing to SharePoint or backing up local changes. This will repair any list exhibiting this symptom.

3044	After syncing a list and filtering it to display only one of multiple subfolders, the full list of subfolders now displays when setting a new filter.
3074	The MSI property, ADMIN_SITE_URL now propagates to the Contributor installation.
3085	The default email address extraction when uploading an email message is now the SMTP address format: e.g. <u>myname@mycompany.com</u> , rather than a mail-system-specific address with type fields identifying the address format. If you prefer to have the mail-system-specific address as before, you can use the MSI property EXTRACT_SMTP_EMAIL_ADDRESSES_ONLY or the registry key ExtractSmtpEmailAddressesOnly with the value of "0" to revert to the prior behavior.

Known Issues

Issue #	Description
2135	When installing Colligo Contributor, users with a 64-bit Operating System and 32-bit Microsoft Office need to manually download the x64 C++ redistributable package.
2169	Users with Outlook 2003 who are using Microsoft Word as their default email editor, will experience abnormal behavior when using Colligo Attachment Manager. For normal functionality, configure Outlook as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. From the Tools menu, select Options. 2. Click the Mail Format tab. 3. In the Message format group, uncheck the following two boxes: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Use Microsoft Office Word 2003 to edit e-mail messages b. Use Microsoft Office Word 2003 to read Rich Text e-mail messages 4. Click Apply.

Issue #	Description
1679	In Microsoft Word 2003, the Send & File and Settings buttons no longer appear within the toolbar.
1696	When Outlook is closed and you choose File > Send (Email) in Microsoft Word, a dialog displaying an unspecified MAPI error no longer displays.
2128	If you change the default behavior for the Send & File setting, then close and restart Outlook, the change in setting is now retained.
2243	With Contributor Uploader, Send & File does not cause the Edit Properties dialog to appear and the email is not filed to SharePoint.
