Resolved Issues

Release 3.4.6 – April 24, 2013	
Reference #	Description
1506	Selecting Email as Link for a list item attachment no longer causes Briefcase to crash.
1550	Previously, if a user selected Global Settings on the app's first launch with no sites in the site list, Briefcase would freeze. This has been resolved.
1552	An Automatic Web Login setting has been added for sites that fail on automatic web login.
1558	If a user adds a new single choice or Boolean values to multiple list items in grid view, the newly populated fields are now pushed successfully to SharePoint on the next sync.
1564	The Email as Attachment now works properly for list item attachments.
1569	Colligo Administrator now supports groups in the Applicability field when pushing configuration settings to Briefcase.

Reference #	Description
1529	Briefcase now includes an option to set a logging level and an option to email the log file.
1531	IT Managers can now push Office 365 sites to Briefcase users in conjunction with Colligo Administrator.

Resolved Issues

Issue #	Description
1435	Previously, if a site was added, deleted, and re-added, the site's metadata and files were downloaded but the content did not display when selected. This has been resolved.
1518	If Briefcase was set to sync every 15 minutes, sometimes the sync failed. This has been resolved. Multiple sites will now be queued to be synced every 15 minutes.
1522	Some videos were not displaying in full-screen mode. This has been resolved.
1526	IT administrators were unable to set the default sync interval as Every Open through Colligo Administrator. This setting is now supported.
1527	If the Preview pane was open, users could not view search results. This has been resolved.
1528	If a Colligo Administrator configuration setting was global but had a Configuration Site Reference, it was not read correctly in Briefcase. This has been resolved.
1533	Users were unable to upload an image as an item attachment while offline. This has been resolved.
1541	If a user rotated the screen when playing a video in full-screen, the video did not rotate to match the screen orientation. This has been resolved.

1542	If a user played a video in full-screen mode, the video couldn't be played again after exiting full-screen mode unless the video is re-selected. This has been resolved.
1543	If a user played a full-screen video on an iPhone 5, the display is black with a title bar at the top of the screen. This has been resolved.
1546	Previously, if a user attempted to upload 2 attachments while offline, the first attachment was successful but the second attachment failed. This has been resolved.

Reference #	Description
957	Users now have the ability to approve or reject items if the SharePoint library supports that functionality.
1246	Users now have the option to sync a read-only sample site when first launching Briefcase to access typical site content.

Resolved Issues

Issue #	Description
774	If there was a conflict around a file's title that a user had resolved, if a file with the same name was uploaded, Briefcase would crash. This has been resolved.
1374	In version 3.3.2, when a user was attempting to view/preview a .doc file, occasionally a Loading indicator was displayed indefinitely. This has been resolved.
1469	On occasions there were files that did not appear in Briefcase after an initial sync. This has been resolved.

Reference #	Description
1340	Briefcase Enterprise now supports single sign-on for sites added from Colligo Administrator.
1371	Briefcase Enterprise now supports custom folder icons through Colligo Administrator. Image files must be added to the Colligo Administrator folder and will display in place of the default icon in Briefcase.

1340	Briefcase now supports Single Sign On (SSO) and auto sign-on for Office 365 sites.

Issue #	Description
930	In Date and Date Time metadata fields, the pickers are now automatically set to the current day when first selected and the option to clear the field is now present.
1277	Briefcase now supports TLS v1.0.
1319	The action that generated the error message “request failed because it redirected too many times” when logging into a SharePoint site, has been fixed.
1329	Previously, files that should have appeared in subfolders were appearing at the root folder level. These files are now appearing in the correct location.
1339	Previously, editing a calendar item caused a crash. This has now been fixed.
1345	When a list is grouped by approval, the items are now grouped by Approved, Pending, and Rejected, instead of 0, 1, and 2.
1346	Users can now successfully upload a SharePoint 2013 file to Briefcase.

Reference #	Description
620	Calendar lists now display graphically as in SharePoint, with day, week, and month views.
857	Users can now apply one or more filters to SharePoint columns to narrow the scope of the data they are viewing.
1148	Users can now create “Playlists,” which allow multiple personal lists of favorite SharePoint items.
1209	When uploading items to Briefcase, a properties screen displays, giving the user the opportunity to enter any relevant metadata for the item, and to choose a content type for the item. Multiple content types per list are now supported.
1210	Using Colligo Administrator, you can now restrict the apps that Briefcase items will Open In (Enterprise version only). If users choose an app that is not on the list of allowable apps, they will receive an error message.
1211	Users can now perform a search of either the local cache in Briefcase, or an online search of the entire SharePoint site.
1297	When uploading a sketch file, the default file name is Sketch.jpg. If this file name already exists, a number is now appended to the name.
1300	Users can now view content directly in SharePoint via an online browser that opens within Briefcase.

832	Users are now able to see the choices/values in a lookup list that are located in a different SharePoint site.
1110	When a file or a file’s metadata is modified but not uploaded, the file now appears in a state that indicates this (yellow sync icon).
1232	The default view is now set correctly when viewing a list/library.
1234	Multi-line Rich Text fields formatting is now viewable.
1230	A progress indicator now displays when data migration is occurring.
1254	When creating a new list item, a yes/no metadata field is now editable.
1282	Users no longer have to exit the calendar view to update the calendar. In addition, the number that indicates how many events are in the calendar now updates correctly.

577	Breadcrumbs have been added for navigational purposes.
587	Users can now upload photos from the iPad camera or from the photo library, as well as free form sketches, to a SharePoint location.
705	Inter-document linking in PDFs is now supported.
815	The list order of views as defined in SharePoint is now honored in the Briefcase views.
818	Search result items now display the full path of the item's location in SharePoint.
826	InfoPath forms are now supported. Users can view, edit, and create new InfoPath forms. Online connectivity is required for full form access. When offline, users can enter metadata for InfoPath form list items and the item is uploaded on the next sync.
835	Check-out/Check-in now occurs when the button is pressed rather than on a sync.
837	When a check-out error occurs, Briefcase displays an error and prevents any data loss
