This release includes a change to the System Requirements. Email Manager for Outlook now requires the Microsoft Visual C++ 2015 Redistributable Package in addition to the Microsoft Visual C++ 2013 Redistributable Package. This release also contains some changes in behavior:

Release 8.0.5 - 03 May 2017

This release includes many new features including an NTLM-based Single Sign-On solution, support for Streams, and support for .pac files. It also comes with a standalone MSI package.

This release also contains a change in behavior for locations which are not pinned. Locations which are not pinned will no longer be regularly synchronized. To manually update a location, right-click it and choose **Synchronize**.
