Colligo Engage runs on x64 and x86 versions of Windows 7, Windows 8, 8.1, and Windows 10.

CON-766	When the Metadata Prompt has been disabled globally by an Administrator, end users will no longer see the disable/enable metadata option in Email Manager for Outlook.
CON-822	RMS files will no longer cause errors during synchronization. Note: This issue will not be resolved until the SharePoint site containing RMS files is removed from Colligo's configuration. The site needs to be re-added and re-synchronized fully in order for the fix to take effect.

CON-244	In Offline mode, when a user drags and drops multiple files which have collisions, only the first collision is detected. Subsequent collisions aren't detected properly, resulting in a user being prompted to resolve sync duplication conflicts.
CON-782	When Colligo Engage for Outlook is installed, the time to switch between folders in the user's mailbox takes a long time. Resolved: Product has been optimized to reduce folder switching time.

CON-775	When using the IE toolbar to add a location that has never previously been added, the user logs in and provides credentials to IE and saves them. The user then clicks the Connect to Outlook app button under the command bar. The user then clicks on Add as Favorite and there is a problem as the credentials were never saved. Workaround: In Outlook, edit the configuration for the site and enter the credentials. Alternatively, add the site from within Outlook.

CON-695	When uploading a batch of new files to a folder, you would sometimes see a message saying that the file conflicted with an earlier version of the file (even though there was no prior version).

CON-710	Using the DisablePST setting may cause Outlook to crash.
CON-714	When using the Colligo Attach feature to attach an email file (.eml) from SharePoint, the attached file loses case sensitivity. Special characters were also not handled.
CON-715	The first time you open Attachment Manager it takes you to where you want to go. Subsequent launches re-open Attachment Manager to where you last left it, which may not be what was selected.
CON-716	Attachment Manager Search searches on Author (person who uploaded to SharePoint) and displays Sender. Resolved: Attachment Manager Search searches on Author and now displays both Author and Sender. Additionally, Search now returns 200 results.
CON-717 CON-740	Cached data (including temporary files) is not fully removed from the computer/device when the site is removed from Colligo Engage.
CON-718	The option to hide Metadata Fields fails when there is a space in the column name.
CON-748	Clicking on "Insert Item/Insert Link" when nothing is selected yields an empty popup. Resolved: It is no longer possible to click the Insert option if nothing is selected.

CON-263	Rebranding of Email Manager and Colligo Briefcase to Colligo Engage. Applications now display the new Colligo Engage branding and logo.
CON-22	In the Outlook View of the Colligo Engage Outlook App, items are displayed in the list with the Subject being the File Name, and the From being the uploader of the Document to SharePoint.
CON-26	In the Colligo Engage Outlook App there is a new view "Outlook View" that is available in the settings. Enabling this mode lets you view the content of the SharePoint folder as an Email folder. Selecting an item in this mode previews the item using the Outlook preview.
CON-28	In the Colligo Engage Offline App, the user can now set a Site to be a Folder. In doing this the current Document Libraries within the SharePoint Site will be added. Any new Document Libraries added after the Site has been added will need to be added individually.

CON-48	After the start-up of Microsoft Outlook, the Colligo Engage Outlook App builds out the folder structure allowing the start-up of Outlook to be within the allowed time for Outlook 2013. The progress of the build out of the folder structure is displayed in the footer of Outlook and once complete the progress bar will disappear automatically.
CON-54	When a user uploads more than 50 items at a time they will be blocked from performing the operation. This number can be altered through an Administrator setting.
CON-55	When a user uploads more than 10 items at a time they will be warned that it may take some time to perform the upload. This number can be altered through an Administrator setting.
CON-57	When Colligo Engage Outlook App is installed in Connected mode and a user uploads emails to SharePoint, the progress of the upload is now displayed in a pane within Outlook so that the user can continue to interact with Outlook. If the user chooses to close the progress window it will re-appear If there is an issue with the upload. While the upload is in progress the user can't upload any more items until the current upload is complete.
CON-69	There is a new option in the Colligo Engage Outlook App to enable you to rename the folders that are available for you to drag and drop to. To do this right click on a Favorite or Folder and select the option to rename. This will bring up options for you to select, or you can specify your own name. If you choose to select a name you will be given the option to set this for all un-modified locations.
CON-125	In the Colligo Engage Windows App you now have the option to clear the filter on columns.

CON-268	The cancel button on the Colligo Engage Outlook App for the build out of folders panel does not cancel the operation successfully.
CON-372	Windows Identity Framework is not identified as pre-requisite software during the installation. If required, you will need to install this manually before the installation of Colligo Engage.
CON-379	When using the Colligo Engage Outlook App in Outlook View mode you may get multiple message boxes asking the user "Do you want to save changes?" This message box can be canceled out of with no effect on items within SharePoint or the local cache.
CON-385	When using the Colligo Engage Outlook App in Outlook View mode the focus of the mouse may not be accurate. This may result in actions on the mouse scroll wheel being directed at locations that are not in focus, such as the ribbon.
CON-386	When a user selects to connect to the Outlook App in Internet Explorer the Site gets added to Colligo Engage, but any Favorites or Folders do not get added. Workaround: To add Favorites or Folders use the Colligo Engage Outlook App configuration options.
