

"ECM is now dead (kaput, finite, an ex-market name)... It's been replaced by the term Content Services."



#### What is a Content Services Platform?

"...a set of services and microservices, embodied either as an integrated product suite or as separate applications that share common APIs and repositories, to exploit diverse content types and to serve multiple constituencies and numerous use cases across an organization."



#### ECM = Business + Transactional Content Services







## **Explosion of Content**


**Proportion of Electronic Content Stored in Various Locations**

#### **Value-based:** we selectively archive to the ECM/RM/ SharePoint system,



**Deferred:** we offload emails to a basic email archive then have fixed deletions, 7%.

# Files Managed, But What About Email?

How would you describe the governance of emails in your organization?

Chaotic: users choose their own archive locations (e.g. local PST files) and deletion policies, 41%.

**Rigid:** fixed deletion periods are enforced on the mail server, 9%.




